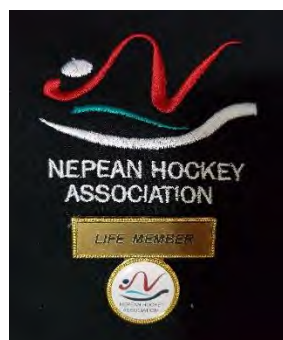

## Carol Morris Junior Umpire Award

*Carol Morris (affectionately known as the Little General) - [1951 - 1998]*

- At the time of Carol's passing Carol was the Technical Convenor for NSW Women's Hockey Association and the leading Junior Umpires Coach in the state
- Involved with forming the CR Blues Club, Penrith, that played in the Western District Women's Competition in 1979
- Western District Women's Association President 1981 to 1986, the Secretary 1987 to 1989.
- Carol had a passion for umpiring and realised that the young needed to be coached into becoming excellent umpires and to enjoy umpiring as well. Organised and coached the Under 14 and Under 16 aspiring umpires at the Easter Coaching clinics and other venues around the state. Carol held a State A Umpires Grade badge
- Became involved with forming the Sydney Women's Hockey League
- Member of the NSW Umpires Committee from 1980 to 1989 and carried out the allocation of umpires to State Championships and evolved into a Technical Official for significant events. Supported the NSW Women's Indoor Hockey movement by participating as an umpire, team manager and technical official
- Supported the Women's Veterans Hockey movement when emerged on then mid 1980's

**Audit Report Qualification**

Receipts from cash donations and other cash fundraising activities are a significant source of revenue for the Nepean Hockey Association. The Nepean Hockey Association has determined that it is impracticable to establish control over the collection of donations and other fundraising activity revenue prior to entry in its financial records. Accordingly, as the evidence available to us about revenue from these sources was limited, our audit procedures for donations and other fundraising activity revenue had to be restricted to the amounts recorded in the financial records. We therefore are unable to express an opinion on whether cash donations and other cash fundraising activity revenue obtained by the Nepean Hockey Association are complete.

Importantly however we managed to have the official opening of the new Amenities/clubhouse building on 15 June 2021, 1 week prior to the COVID lockdown.

We have been able to continue reduction in lease fees to zero for 2021 from the Western Sydney University. Discussions are ongoing for ongoing rental relief that will allow us to continue to re-invest in the Hockey Centre.

Once again, the Canteen was run internally by the Turf Committee in 2021 and whilst with a limit on what we could sell due to COVID-19 restrictions, we once again had a successful season. I would like to thank Noelene Knowles and Marnie Shortis in particular for their hard work in keeping the canteen stocked and ready to go. Once again, any money made from the canteen will be reinvested in the Hockey Centre.

We also secured our permanent liquor licence for the Centre (Noelene Knowles is the registered Licensee) and thanks must go to Angela Frost (Solicitor) who undertook the application for us on a pro-bono basis. A number of the turf committee members now have their RSA.

2022 will see us hosting the U34/40's Men's Masters State Championships on 8th – 10th April.

Our highlights for 2021 include:

The completion of the new clubhouse (made possible through the Greater Sydney Sports Facility Fund)

In this regard we would like to thank Bruce Taggart who took on the role of Project Manager.

We were successful in securing the following Grant funding:

- \$16,390.00 (Local Sports Program) for the concrete pathways around the new clubhouse.
- \$7,500 from Penrith Council to concrete under the relocated Awning shelter

Grants still under consideration include:

- Upgraded LED lighting for both fields (\$487,929.00)
- 4 x new hockey goals (\$15,540.00)

Work will start on the upgrade the existing canteen building in December using the grant funding that we received in 2020. This building will become an admin building for tournaments and smaller meetings. We also plan to extend the deck at the front for another viewing area.

I'd like to take this opportunity to thank all members of the Turf Committee – Noelene Knowles, Scott Williams, Marnie Shortis and Michael Hughes; and non-voting member Kieran Knowles - for their fantastic work and support this season. I'd also like to thank the following people for their tireless work at the Hockey Centre:

We look forward to a great 2022 season.

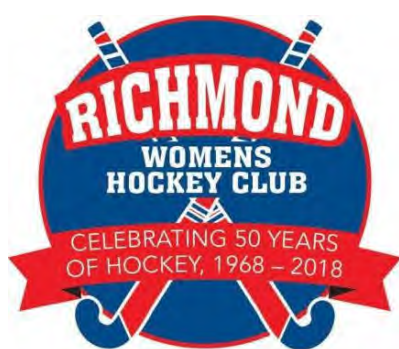
